The Story Behind the Fuel

Distilled by Pauley Hollow Distillery in Pike County, Kentucky, Fuel of the Feud moonshine is made from water drawn from the Randolph McCoy well, which is located on the property where, on New Years Eve, 1888, the Hatfields attacked the McCoy homeplace, burning it to the ground.

McCoy Well owner, and Hatfield descendant, Bob Scott, along with his wife Rita, worked tirelessly over the course of the past few years to make this product a reality.

Keeping with Hatfield & McCoy tradition, Fuel of the Feud is made from a mashbill of West Virginia corn and Kentucky rye, along with malted barley and cane sugar. This 100 proof moonshine has an initial sweet corn flavor with a spicy rye finish.
